TAKING ENERGY CODES SERIOUSLY

After two years of requiring documentation of energy code compliance, the NYC Department of Buildings (DOB) is going to start auditing design submissions, revoking permits when appropriate. And beginning early next year, DOB will require inspections to verify that projects are built to code.

Since almost 80% of New York City's carbon emissions come from buildings, energy code compliance is central to fulfilling the City's commitment to reduce emissions by 30% by 2030.

The City of New York has requested that the AIANY, ASHRAE and the Urban Green Council join forces to offer three sessions to train design professionals on the energy code. The sessions will cover meeting the energy code, preparing submittals, and documenting compliance.
